The Central Bank is responsible for publishing official statistics on the Irish financial sector.

We do this by collecting data under specific legislation governing the production of official statistics.

However, the bank has access to a large volume of other data sets, collected for a variety of purposes, in order for us to perform our full range of tasks and to meet our mandate effectively.

In line with our ambition to transform how we use research, analysis, and data, our new Frontier Statistics Series aims to make use of some of these other data sets, to publish new information to users, and to share novel insights on topics of interest to the general public.

We have two main objectives with Frontier Statistics.

Firstly, we're seeking to respond to the ever-growing demand for information and statistics, by drawing from a more extensive range of data sources.

Some of the data sets available to us in the bank are very granular in nature, and that really allows us to shine a light on specific aspects of the financial landscape or in financial products of particular interest to consumers, for example.

Secondly, we're transforming how we communicate with our audience. We are seeking to provide a more visual, interactive product offering, and we'll be refining these products over time based on the feedback we get from our users.
